

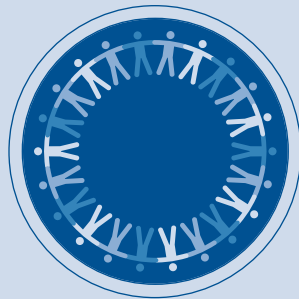

Sister Joan (Marie Angele) Panella 50 Years a Sister of Notre Dame

Sr. Joan Panella taught in elementary and secondary schools, including Sacred Heart and



Madonna in Salinas, and Notre Dame High School in Alameda. As a counselor at Notre Dame High School in San Jose, she "loved helping the girls grow and change and make something of all

their difficulties," she says. Later, while working in campus ministry at San Jose State University, she assisted with the San Jose Diocese's groundbreaking outreach ministry to gay and lesbian Catholics. Later, what began as an internship for Sr. Joan's degree in social work turned into fourteen fulfilling years in a neurological rehabilitation unit at Community Hospital in Los Gatos—a faith-stretching experience for someone with an aversion to hospitals! Sr. Joan is currently the Residence Coordinator of the Province Center.

Sister Paula (Catherine Dolores) Butier 60 Years a Sister of Notre Dame

Sister Paula Butier's beautiful singing voice led to a degree in music and to teaching chorale,

one of the loves of her life. Sr. Paula served as a teacher and administrator at Notre Dame high schools in San Jose and San Francisco, and for twenty five years in Belmont, most of these as principal. She also



served as Assistant Superintendent for Secondary Schools in the San Francisco Archdiocesan Department of Education. In 1989 she was honored by the National Catholic Education Association (NCEA) for her "remarkable contribution to Catholic secondary education in the United States." Today, Sr. Paula keeps in touch with hundreds of parents and former students.

After surviving polio as a teenager in Marysville Sr. Ann Stubbe knew that God intended something special for her life. And she was right—sixty years as a Sister of Notre Dame proved to be that something special. Her early years were spent as a primary and Montessori teacher. She also had the challenge and pleasure of “re-creating” two day care centers, one that had only seven students and two teachers when she took over. Sr. Ann’s six years as a Head Start Supervisor in a West Virginia coal-mining community holds a special spot in her heart. Sr. Ann volunteers at the Province Center.

Sister Christina Marie Trudeau

60 Years a Sister of Notre Dame

When Sister Christina Marie taught her first class at St. Joseph’s School in San Jose, she learned about Dr. Maria Montessori’s work with young children and thus found her life-long mission. After teaching in classrooms in San Jose, Los Angeles, and Marysville, Sister opened the Notre Dame Early Learning Center in Belmont and started the Early Childhood and Montessori Teacher



Training programs at then College of Notre Dame. She has trained teachers at Seattle University, Chaminade University in Honolulu, and Notre Dame Seishin University in Okayama, Japan, and in India, the Philippines and Tahiti. Sixty years later, Sr. Christina is still teaching, this time at Casa de la Cultura in Pajaro, a farm-worker community near Watsonville.

70 Years a Sister of Notre Dame

As a Sister of Notre Dame, Sr. Marie Barbara fulfilled her early desire to become a teacher. For over 40 years Sister taught history and social studies with energy and enthusiasm. She adapted to changing classroom styles and students from diverse cultures and backgrounds at Notre Dame High School in San Francisco, Blanchet High School in Seattle, Mora High School in

Watsonville and Notre Dame High School in Belmont. Sr. Marie Barbara still has a sense of humor, a good eye for photography, a love of reading and catching up with old friends. Now living with other SNDs at Mercy Retirement

and Care Center in Oakland, she continues to pray for past students and many friends.



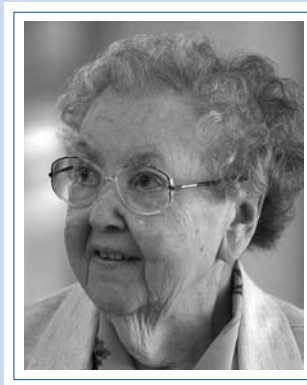

Sister Catherine Arnoldy
80 Years a Sister of Notre Dame

Sister's first teaching assignment was to the third and fourth grades at Notre Dame School in Chico. She was then asked to serve at Dolores School in Santa Barbara, Our Lady of Mt. Carmel in Redwood City, then, to her delight, back to Chico. Her influence there extended beyond the school and parish as students from Chico State College came to observe her teaching and learn from her. Later, Sister Catherine became the first principal of St. Stephen's School in Portland, Oregon, and served at Sacred Heart School, Salinas, St. Francis High School, Sacramento, and Notre Dame high schools in Salinas and Alameda. At age 98, she celebrated her Jubilee at Holy Names Convent in Los Gatos, where she lives. She remains active and daily prays for former students, family and friends.

Together, as the extended Notre Dame community, we do make a difference!

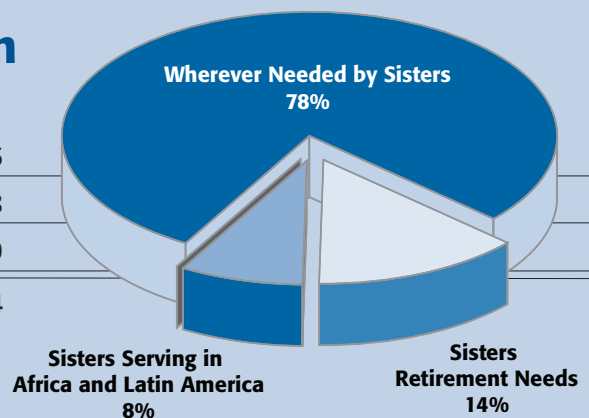

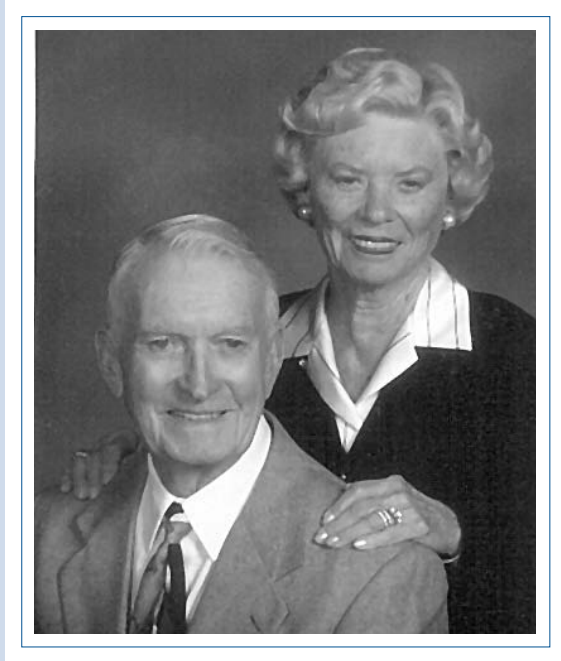

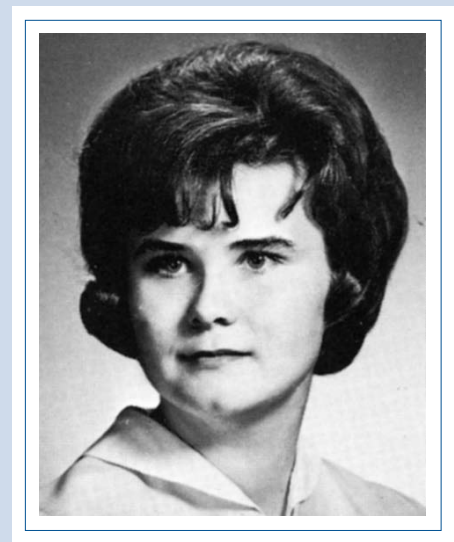

Nickola and Marilyn Mardesich made the very generous bequest of their home to the Sisters of Notre Dame.

For most of his life, Nick was a hard-working Santa Clara Valley orchardist. When he and his wife finally sold most of the property they had acquired over the years, they kept their 1930's home built on an acre of one of their former orchards in Sunnyvale. Marilyn was an avid "antiquer," collecting so many interesting things that Nick built a shed and a warehouse on the property for her to store them.

The Mardesiches enjoyed knowing the Sisters who were their tenants for a few years in a small house across the street from their own home; Nick also held the brother-in-law of one of those Sisters in high regard. In 1997, the Mardesiches spoke with Development staff about their estate plans. They had decided to remember family members and some charities in their Trust and to leave their home and property to the Sisters. Both Nick, who died in 1998, and Marilyn, who died in 2005, knew in their lifetime how much their gift meant to Sisters of Notre Dame.

A plaque at the Province Center will be a reminder of the Mardesich legacy; Nick and Marilyn will always be remembered gratefully and prayerfully by the Sisters.

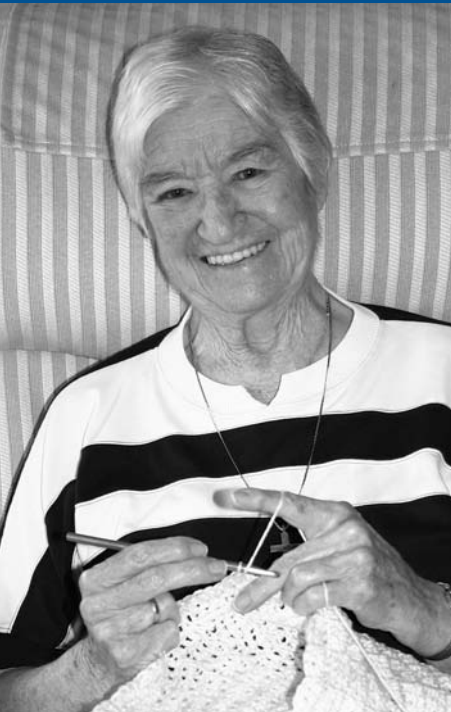
